The date of mailing is the date noted below in Clerk's Certificate and the date of posting is the date noted thereon by the Sheriff/Process Server. The provisions of section 83.232, Florida Statutes, may apply to this action which requires the tenant to pay into the registry of the court accrued rent as alleged or as determined by the court. Any payment required into the registry of the court must be cash, cashier's check or money order, wire transfer or attorney's trust account check (\$5,000 or less). A defendant may either file the response using the E-Filing Portal (MyFLCourtAccess.com), or by filing the response with the clerk of court. If a defendant fails to do so, a default will be entered against the defendant for the relief demanded in the complaint.
